REPORTS Realignment of Library and Citizen Services

Ian Wood, Interim General Manager of Community Development

updated the Greater Sudbury Public Library Board with the most recent realignment at the City of Greater Sudbury, namely that the Libraries and Heritage Resources and Citizen Services Sections will, effective September 3, 2019, fall under the Communications and Community Engagement Division which will report to Ian as the Executive Director. Ian explained his role would also be changing effective September 9th, 2019 when Steve Jacques joins the City of Greater Sudbury as the new General Manager of Community Development. With the recent resignation of Chelsie Abraham, Mette Krüger has been appointed into the Manager of Libraries and Heritage Resources position until the vacancy is permanently filled.

Verbal Report re: Large Project Update (The Junction)

Ian Wood presented an update on the Library/Art Gallery project. Work is still being done to secure the site, however geotechnical assessment has been completed, with more positive results than anticipated. There have been discussions with the Sudbury Theatre Centre and the Sudbury Multicultural Folk Arts Association about potential partnerships and integration in the Library/Art Gallery project. This project will be soon moving to the design phase.

Auditor General's Report

Michael Bellmore advised the Governance Audit of the Greater Sudbury Public Library is now complete. The report has been released to him as the Chair. Michael will share the results in the upcoming board meeting.
