Junction East Presentation - Ian Wood

Update on New Central Library Project - Colleen Burns

C. Burns gave the group an update of the New Central Library beginning with a Communications update. The Social Campaign has ended. Collen thanked the Board Members who subscribe to the newsletter. Colleen went over the floor plans for new library addressing concerns including universal accessibility, flexibility and branch vs. central services. The remaining concerns are noise mitigation, truth and reconciliation and the staffing of three floors.

B. Harding discussed the Museums revitalization plan and advised that Council has approved the plan and work is underway. I. Wood will give an update at the April meeting.

The New Central Library Update report going to City Council has been delayed.

The Board discussed the contribution of capital costs to the project, the proceeds of the sale of MacKenzie Library going towards the project and what amount of library reserves should be put towards the project.

Pandemic Exit Plan

Brian spoke to the Pandemic Exit Plan report which outlines areas where Library service levels remain below pre-pandemic levels along with strategies to return these areas to regular service levels.
