

Salama's interest in horticulture can be seen throughout the book when she repeats names of flowers and their properties to herself as a way to calm down and find peace.

Layla's paintings have rich hues of colours, in particular blue, which Salama wishes she could see in the world. Kenan takes Salama to see the sunset and says they deserve to see the colours.

In this activity, we will use colouring as a calming technique, learn about various flowers mentioned in the novel, and use our creativity to colour them in non-traditional shades and hues.





#### **Daisies**

In Chapter 1, Salama references daisies. Daisies symbolize innocence, cheerfulness, and purity. In Celtic mythology, legend has it that when a child died, the Gods sprinkled daisies onto the Earth to cheer up the grieving parents. While no flower could replace such a significant loss, the flowers brought small smiles to the parents' faces.





#### Roses


Roses are referenced often in the novel. In one instance, white roses, a symbol of purity, are referred to in a flashback of Hamza and Layla's wedding. In another, a military man is killed and referred to as the man with the roses. Roses are often associated with war, heraldry, and badges.





#### Gardenia

Salama repeats the name of the flower, gardenia in chapter 20 and says that it alleviates depression, anxiety and stress.





### Going Social


At times the plot of the novel is pushed forward through social media posts on the platform, *Poster*, which has similarities to our real-life social media platforms.

### Movie Casting and Poster




- 1. Create a cast list, including the director. Who would you cast for the main roles?

Time Capsule Chart


